

**Meeting of the Annual Parish Meeting held in the Village Hall  
Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2008 at 7:30pm**

Present: Bryan Pitman (Chair), David Charles, Lesley Greensmith, Terry McGrath, Brian Murchie, Derek Newman, the Clerk, 2 representatives from Hertfordshire Police and 35 members of the public.

1. Apologies for absence: Jim Ranger and Jane Pitman
2. The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2008 were approved as a correct record.
3. Bryan Pitman welcomed invited visitors and members of the public and presented the annual report of the Parish council. A copy of the report is held on file with the minutes. The financial report was given by the Clerk. Summary accounts held on file with the minutes.
4. Bryan Pitman read a letter/report from Jim Ranger, held on file
5. Sgt Duncan Wallace and PCSO Joanna Alston attended on behalf of the local **Police**.

Sgt Wallace lives in Buntingford where there are 2 police officers, one dedicated to schools. The locality plan is to detect and prevent crime and Sgt Wallace's preference is to prevent crime. He hopes that the Parish will provide a representative to attend meetings on the local plan. Speeding is seen as a big issue in most places but generally we live in a low crime area and the statistics show a reduction of 3% and a higher detection rate. The start of the new year continued to show a fall in crime in this area.

Previously there was a mobile police station which toured the area, this has been replaced by the PCSOs making themselves available at pre-advertised times, in the village hall car park but so far no one has been to visit them while in Cottered. They urge residents to come along for a chat even if there are no perceived issues.
