*ASB is not defined as 'crime' however it has been included in this table for your information as it can affect the wider community and we (police) are jointly responsible with local councils for dealing with it. Recordable ASB includes neighbour disputes, noise nuisance and fly tipping etc.

The figure now provided includes all ASB – environmental, nuisance and personal.

Please note that there has been a change in the way burglary offences are recorded nationally. They are now classified as:

Burglary Residential – all buildings within the boundaries of a property, including sheds and garages **Burglary Business and Community** – buildings that are solely for business purposes or are otherwise outside the classification of residential burglary, such as a sports club or place of worship.
